1. Services and Duties

Bartender agrees to provide professional bartending services at the event described above, including service of alcoholic beverages only to persons of legal drinking age in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

2. Licensing and Compliance

Bartender represents and warrants to have all necessary licenses, permits, and qualifications required by law to perform the services described herein and agrees to comply with all federal, state, and local laws, including but not limited to alcohol service laws.

3. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall commence upon execution and continue until completion of services at the event. Either party

may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party materially breaches any term of this Agreement and fails to cure within three (3) business days.

4. Payment

Client agrees to pay the Bartender the fees as specified above. Deposit, if any, shall be non-refundable except as otherwise agreed in writing. Balance is due as stated and payable by cash, check, or other agreed method. Late payments shall accrue interest at the rate of 1.5% per month or the maximum permitted by law.

5. Independent Contractor Status

Bartender is an independent contractor and not an employee or agent of Client. Bartender shall be solely responsible for all taxes, insurance, and benefits relating to payments received under this Agreement.

6. Liability and Insurance

Bartender shall maintain general liability insurance covering the services to be performed. Client shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses incurred by Bartender or third parties arising from Bartender's performance of services.

7. Indemnification

Each party agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other party from and against any claims, liabilities, damages, or expenses arising from breach of this Agreement or negligence.

8. Alcohol Liability

Bartender shall not serve alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and shall comply with all applicable alcohol service laws. Client indemnifies Bartender from any liability arising from Client's failure to provide a lawful environment.

9. Confidentiality

The parties agree to maintain confidentiality of the terms and any proprietary information disclosed during the term of this Agreement.

10. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, government restrictions, strikes, and other unforeseen events.

11. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior oral or written agreements, negotiations, or understandings.

12. Amendments

No amendment or modification to this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.

13. Governing Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____ without regard to its conflict of laws principles. The parties consent to exclusive jurisdiction and venue in the state or federal courts located in _____ County, _____.

14. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

15. Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute waiver of such provision or any other rights.

16. Notices

All notices shall be in writing and deemed given when delivered personally, sent by nationally recognized overnight courier, certified mail return receipt requested, or electronic means that confirm transmission and receipt, to the parties at their addresses specified herein or as later designated.

17. Assignment

Neither party may assign or transfer this Agreement or any rights or obligations hereunder without prior written consent of the other party.

18. Counterparts; Electronic Signatures

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and signatures transmitted electronically shall have the same effect as original signatures.

19. Compliance with Laws

Both parties agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations in performing their obligations under this Agreement.

20. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall first be attempted to be resolved through good faith negotiation. If unresolved, the parties may seek mediation or arbitration before pursuing litigation.
