

CAREGIVER SERVICES AGREEMENT

Term of Agreement:

This Agreement shall commence upon the date above and continue until terminated by either party in accordance with this Agreement.

Scope of Services:

Caregiver agrees to provide personal care services, companionship, and assistance with daily living activities as agreed upon with the Care Recipient. Caregiver shall perform services in a professional, respectful, and competent manner in accordance with applicable laws and ethical standards. Caregiver will report any changes in the Care Recipient's condition or service needs promptly.

Hours and Schedule:

Caregiver shall provide services during the agreed-upon schedule, which may be subject to adjustment by mutual consent of the parties. Any changes to schedule must be communicated in advance.

Compensation:

Care Recipient agrees to pay Caregiver at the rate of \$_____ per hour/session. Payment shall be made on a _____ basis (e.g., weekly, biweekly, monthly) by _____ (method of payment). Any overtime or additional services must be pre-approved and compensated accordingly.

Independent Contractor Status:

Caregiver is an independent contractor and not an employee of the Care Recipient. Caregiver is responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes arising from payments made under this Agreement. Caregiver is not entitled to any benefits provided to employees of Care Recipient.

Confidentiality:

Caregiver agrees to maintain confidentiality of all personal, medical, and financial information concerning the Care Recipient and their family. Confidential information shall not be disclosed without prior written consent except as required by law.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time by providing written notice to the other party. Upon termination, Caregiver shall return any property belonging to the Care Recipient and cease providing services. Final payment for

services rendered shall be made within _____ days of termination.

Indemnification and Liability:

Care Recipient agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Caregiver from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from services provided under this Agreement, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct by Caregiver. Caregiver shall maintain appropriate insurance coverage as required by law or agreed upon by the parties.

Compliance with Laws:

Caregiver agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and licensing requirements in the performance of services. Care Recipient agrees to provide a safe working environment.

Dispute Resolution:

Any disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved first through good faith negotiation between the parties. If unresolved, disputes shall be submitted to mediation before a mutually agreed mediator. If mediation fails, disputes may be resolved in a court of competent jurisdiction as specified below.

Governing Law and Venue:

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of _____. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts located in _____ County, _____, for any legal action arising under this Agreement.

Entire Agreement:

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior discussions, agreements, or understandings of any kind. Any amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Severability:

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
