Clause 1 – Scope of Services

Decorator agrees to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary to complete the decoration project described above in a professional manner consistent with industry standards.

Clause 2 – Changes and Modifications

Any changes or modifications to the scope of services must be made in writing and signed by both parties. Such changes may result in adjustments to the contract price and/or schedule.

Clause 3 – Completion and Schedule

Decorator agrees to commence work promptly and to complete the project within the agreed schedule. Any delays must be communicated in writing with reasons and new estimated completion dates.

Clause 4 – Payment Terms

Client shall pay the deposit specified above upon execution of this Agreement. Remaining balance shall be paid according to the agreed schedule or upon completion of the project, whichever occurs first.

Clause 5 – Client Responsibilities

Client shall provide access to the project site, approvals, and any necessary permits or authorizations required for the Decorator to perform the work.

Clause 6 – Warranties

Decorator warrants that all work will be performed in a professional manner and that materials supplied will be of good quality and free from defects under normal use for a period of one year after completion.

Clause 7 – Indemnification

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other against any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from the indemnifying party's negligence or willful misconduct in connection with this Agreement.

Clause 8 – Insurance

Decorator shall maintain adequate insurance coverage including general liability and worker's compensation as required by law and provide certificates of insurance upon request.

Clause 9 – Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party fails to cure a material breach within 14 days after receipt of notice. Upon termination, Client shall pay for all work performed to date.

Clause 10 – Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be resolved first through good faith negotiation. If unsuccessful, disputes shall be submitted to binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

Clause 11 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____ without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

Clause 12 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, whether written or oral.

Clause 13 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Clause 14 – Notices

All notices shall be in writing and deemed delivered when sent by certified mail, hand delivery, or nationally recognized overnight courier to the addresses set forth above.

Clause 15 – Assignment

Neither party may assign or transfer their rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party.

Clause 16 – Independent Contractor

Decorator is an independent contractor and is not an employee, agent, or partner of the Client.

Clause 17 – Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for delays or failure to perform due to events beyond their reasonable control, including but

not limited to acts of God, war, strikes, or governmental actions.

Clause 18 – Confidentiality

Parties agree to keep confidential any proprietary or sensitive information disclosed during the course of this Agreement.

Clause 19 – Non-Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of that provision or any other provision.

Clause 20 – Signatures

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together constitute one agreement.
