Section 1 – Declaration of Intent

Both parties declare their full and free consent to the Nikah (marriage contract) without any coercion, duress, or undue influence, in accordance with Islamic law (Sharia) and United States law.

Section 2 – Mahr (Dower)

The Groom agrees to pay the agreed Mahr to the Bride as a mandatory gift and a symbol of respect and responsibility. The Mahr is specified above and shall be paid in full as described in this contract.

Section 3 – Responsibilities of the Groom

The Groom agrees to provide maintenance, protection, and all rights granted under Islamic law and United States law throughout the marriage. The Groom commits to treating the Bride with kindness, equity, and respect.

Section 4 – Responsibilities of the Bride

The Bride agrees to fulfill her obligations as prescribed by Islamic law and United States law, including respect and cooperation towards the Groom, while maintaining her rights fully.

Section 5 – Witnesses

This contract is witnessed by the individuals named above who confirm the witnessing of this Nikah agreement, validating its authenticity under religious and secular authorities.

Section 6 – Governing Law

This contract shall be governed by the laws of the United States of America and applicable State laws. In case of any conflict between Sharia and United States law, United States law shall prevail to the extent applicable.

Section 7 – Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from this contract shall first be attempted to be resolved amicably through mediation or arbitration by qualified Islamic scholars and/or legal professionals within the jurisdiction. If unresolved, parties may seek legal remedy in courts of appropriate jurisdiction.

Section 8 – Termination and Divorce

The rights and procedures for termination of the marriage (Talaq or Khula) shall be conducted in accordance with applicable Islamic principles and United States law, ensuring fairness, legal compliance, and protection of both parties' rights.

Section 9 – Confidentiality

The parties agree to keep the terms of this contract and any related personal information confidential except as required by law or necessary for enforcement.

Section 10 – Entire Agreement

This contract contains the entire understanding between the parties concerning the Nikah. No other agreements, verbal or written, shall override this contract.

Section 11 – Amendments

Any amendments to this contract must be made in writing and signed by both parties and witnessed appropriately.

Section 12 – Signatures and Execution

The undersigned parties affirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to all terms of this Islamic Marriage Contract, signing willingly and with full knowledge.
