Scope of Work:

Content Creator agrees to create and deliver User Generated Content (UGC) for the Company in accordance with the specifications, deadlines, and quality standards set forth in this Agreement or any attached schedule. Content shall be original, lawful, and free from third-party rights or claims.

Grant of Rights:

Content Creator hereby grants Company a worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, sublicensable license to use, reproduce, distribute, display, perform, adapt, and create derivative works of the Content in all media now known or hereafter devised, for any commercial or non-commercial purpose including advertising, marketing, and promotional activities.

Compensation:

Company agrees to pay Content Creator as follows: [Specify payment amount, terms, milestones, and method of payment]. No further compensation shall be due unless agreed in writing.

Delivery and Acceptance:

Indemnification:

Content Creator agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Company and its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents from any claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses arising from breach of representations or warranties or any claim that the Content infringes any third-party rights.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party materially breaches any term and fails to cure within a reasonable period. Upon termination, Company shall pay for all Content delivered and accepted prior to termination.

Independent Contractor:

Content Creator is an independent contractor and nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as creating an employer-employee relationship, partnership, joint venture, or agency.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____, without regard to its conflict-of-law principles. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of state or federal courts located in _____ County, _____.

Miscellaneous:

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral. Any amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties. If any provision is found invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
